

# AMI Days

I've put together some papers for possible AMI Days (Alternative Method of Instruction). These days will be used in the event of multiple snow days. Dr. Burrell will announce AMI Days via textcaster and I will let you know, also.

I'll be rewarding students who turn in their work. There will be two papers assigned for each AMI day. If you have Internet access, your child can also incorporate technology (at least 20 minutes) by using educational websites/apps. I've attached a log-in sheet. Websites I recommend are: [starfall.com](http://starfall.com), [abcya.com](http://abcya.com), [funbrainjr.com](http://funbrainjr.com), and [education.com/games](http://education.com/games). All of them are free! You can also check out some educational apps on your electronic device. Please write down any educational sites that you use and what your child did on that site. Kids will be rewarded for showing responsibility. They will receive one bird buck for returning each of their papers and one bird buck for computer time. They have an opportunity to receive a total of 3 bird bucks for each AMI Day.

**Materials needed for AMI Days: sharpened pencil, crayons or colored pencils, scissors, and glue stick.** What can parents do? Please sit down with your child, explain the work, and provide supervision as needed. There are some papers that include cutting. Check to see that your child is holding the scissors correctly and going slow. Please help your child show responsibility by reminding him/her to put the paper in the "Return to School" side of the folder.

If we have one or more AMI days, I will communicate with you via Remind or email to let you know what the assignment will be for that day. This envelope should be set aside and used only for AMI days. Please let me know if you have any questions.
